Brampton City Update:

- 1. City looking for ride leaders for **Bike to Work Day** Court House, Mount Pleasant, Sandalwood bus terminal. Focus on rides in from city facilities.
- 2. Discussion about \$1.7m allocation for community infrastructure

Regional Update:

- 1. <u>Bike to School Week</u> (B2SW) last week of May. 116 registered in Peel so far. Private schools being approached for first time this year. Discussion centred around "being cool" to ride to school. Statistically, youth are delaying getting their drivers licenses. Dayle updated B2SW webpage.
- 2. <u>Bike Month</u> Book Ride, Bramalea CycleFest, Bike to Work Day, CeleBrampton BikeFest, Bike the Creek see events for details
- 3. **PSARTS** (Peel Safe and Active Routes to School) update next month
- 4. Discussion about AT Implementation Plan and need for milestones in long term plans. Discussion about Regional Council's role in holding accountability for staff in all plans. **Action:** Dayle to find if posted on Walk+Roll website.

Community Engagement

1. <u>Brampton Bike Hub</u> (Canadabikes.org EcoAction Grant, partnering with PCHS) – David reported that he and community mentor Stephen Samuel started bike club at Bramalea Secondary School as part of EcoAction Brampton Bike Hub BikeWrx outreach. 7 kids stayed after school (3:15-5pm). Students

- wanted to learn advanced tasks like stringing cables. Initially students thought this club was about motor bikes, but none left. Peel's 10-Step High School Handbook was used.
- 2. Pedalwise Program, part of Brampton Bike Hub. Everyone encouraged to register for free Strava, and sign up for EcoAction Club, log commuting trips. Make sure you give Kevin permission to aggregate the data for collection for our program reporting!
- 3. **National Bike Summit, Ottawa** May 28-30th. David and Dayle will attend. David will be presenting update on Brampton Bike Hub as part of Velo-Canada-Bikes EcoAction program grant.
- 4. **Transition Aids to Youth** (TAY), Peel Memorial Hospital approached David for program benefitting 16-18yr olds focussing on physical activity. George to assist when David not available. Bikes borrowed for program. Helmets donated by Region of Peel.

BikeBrampton Projects:

 Promotion: Social Media & Website Facebook page likes continue to increase every week. Twitter campaign to start 60 days before Bike the Creek.

2. Prioritized list of infrastructure projects

TRCA Trails:

- a. **Etobicoke Creek Trail** surfacing north of Mayfield planned for paving in 2019. Brampton owns 600m north of Mayfield. Being coordinated between Brampton & Caledon with TRCA.
- b. Valleywood-Southfields trail & bridge: Official Opening, Bike the Creek, Town Ride 11am, Jun 23rd
- c. **Kennedy Valley Trail** extension- Kennedy Road to Westcreek Blvd in time for Bike the Creek's City Loop Ride.
- d. **Sherway Trail** construction 2019 construction. Bridge under QEW will be proceeding. **BikeBrampton priorities:**
- a. Heart Lake Road Mitigation strategy David and Dayle sitting on TAC (Technical Advisory Committee) Awaiting 2nd TAC. Heart Lake Wetland Complex is 7th out of 2260 most important provincially significant wetland on MNR's Ontario Wetland Evaluation System. Heart Lake Road AT blog as result of 1st PIC held Nov 2nd. Heart Lake is part of Brampton city loop, connecting Esker Lake Trail, up Heart Lake Road, through Heart Lake Conservation Area to Mayfield Rd.

- b. Worn pavement lines on existing infrastructure (eg. Bonny Braes Road, Rutherford, Bleasdale)
 Members' responses to 311 calls have occasionally been prompt and have occasionally required follow up calls. Discussion about benefit and positive visibility for city to acknowledge the 311 caller again, once issue has been fixed.
- c. Clairville & Queen St E intersection Steve reported this intersection requires a "no u turn" sign. Ebenezer is a safer route. follow up required
- d. Finch & Steeles intersection Lisa reported this intersection should have a "beg" button to allow crossing from north to south follow up required

City of Brampton Infrastructure:

- a. Franchesini bridge across #410– project near completion with Esker Lake path connections official opening Bike the Creek, City Loop and Nature Rides, Jun 23rd 10:45am
- b. BFIP projects Traffic Calming N/A
