

2021 BikeWrX Pop Up COVID-19 Workplace Safety Plan

[Ontario Rules for Areas in Stage 3](#) – Ontario Regulation 520/21 – effective July 16, 2021

- The booth manager is responsible for COVID-19 protocol adherence.
- The booth manager has the authority to suspend service to an individual participant or to shut down the event completely if crowds become too large, people are not complying with proper physical distancing, or the situation is deemed to be unmanageable in any way.
- Staff and volunteers will be trained in accordance with this plan.
- Staff and volunteers use hand sanitizer before and after interacting with a visitor.
- Request visitors approaching registration table to use hand sanitizer before they sign in.
- Request everyone who is getting any type of service to register and give contact tracing detail.
- Request visitors to read and acknowledge the waiver when they sign in.
- Use orange cones to space line-ups to at least 2 metres between visitors. (Visitors from same household excepted)
- Staff and volunteers to wear a mask if they cannot be physically distanced by at least 2 metres from everyone else (vaccination status is not mentioned in the regulation).
- Visitors to wear a mask if they are coming within 2 metres of staff/volunteers.
- Mask must cover mouth, nose and chin, unless they are entitled to any of the exceptions set out in subsection 2 (4) of Schedule 1.
- If maskless, visitors should hand over bike and keep their distance from others while their bike is being worked upon.
- Separate repair stands by at least 2 metres.
- Disposable gloves provided for those working on bikes. Use garbage bag for glove disposal.
- Maximum 100 visitors for outdoor event.
