 - c. DS received donation of bikes from Church of the Latter-Day Saints. Really good quality mountain bikes with accessories.

- 1. Region announced resurrection of bike rack for schools program. School pays only for installation costs which is a barrier. Contact, Jennifer Andrade.
- 2. CAA is funding bike racks for businesses through Brampton Bike Friendly Business program.

BikeBrampton Projects

- 1. Bike the Creek David reported routes are being finalized
- 2. Bill 212 Charter Challenge Court provided a temporary injunction while judge reviews merits of charter challenge
- 3. Steve indicated Toronto Council has requested a staff report looking at causes of congestion related to construction vs. bike lanes
- 4. Dayle reported BikeBrampton has been invited to attend **Rose Orchestra** evening on April 26th

- 5. Dayle, David and Polly are planning to attend George's induction into **Brampton Sports Hall of Fame**, May 6th.
- 6. **Brampton Orangeville Rail Trail** David asked George to make a presentation to the Credit Valley Trail Association to see about combining forces with BORT to develop more momentum to get the trail built in Brampton. BORT provides an opportunity to use already purchased land for the CVT property near the Credit River is mostly private. **David will invite George to attend the next CVT meeting.**

- 2. David indicated ~ 30 people attended the **BEA AGM** on March 19th and six new Board members were elected.

Caledon Update

- Wayne reported
 - a. Sabrina Davidson has left her active transportation planning position at the Town
 - b. 2 new commissioners being hired
 - c. Currently repairing storm erosion damage on Caledon Trailway, Recommend stay off until trail dries and hardens in a few weeks, especially if riding on skinny tires.
 - d. Moutainview will receive a quick shave and pave project this summer
 - e. Blue bridge repairs scheduled to start soon
 - f. Problems with falling concrete chunks along trail at Hwy 9 overpass, looks like repairs will start soon which may affect accessibility.
- 2. Wayne said he recently has been doing more riding in Brampton and noted bicycle infrastructure improvements. There is tourism potential tying Caledon and Brampton together.
